HOUSE RESOLUTION 10 - EMPLOYEE FREE CHOICE ACT

House Resolution 10 would memorialize the Congress of the United States **to enact** the Employee Free Choice Act, which would authorize the National Labor Relations Board to certify a union as the bargaining representative when a majority of employees voluntarily sign authorizations designating that union to represent them; provide for first contract mediation and arbitration; and establish meaningful penalties for violations of a worker's freedom to choose a union.

AFT MICHIGAN POSITION - YES

HOUSE VOTE #14: 67 YES / 40 NO / 0 EXCUSED / 3 NOT VOTING

SENATE RESOLUTION 16 - EMPLOYEE FREE CHOICE ACT

Senate Resolution 16 would memorialize Congress **to oppose** the Employee Free Choice Act. The Employee Free Choice Act would make it easier for unions to organize and would protect workers' rights to organize.

AFT MICHIGAN POSITION - NO

HOUSE VOTE #14: 20 YES / 15 NO / 20 EXCUSED / 0 NOT VOTING

HOUSE BILL 4030 - COMPULSORY SCHOOL AGE

House Bill 4030 would require students to attend high school until they are 18 years old or graduate, unless their parent or guardian gives consent for them to drop out after the age of 16. This legislation would apply to students who turned 14 on or after December 1, 2007 or who were 14 prior to that date but had already entered ninth grade by 2008.

HOUSE BILL 4313 - SINKING FUNDS

House Bill 4313 would revise the purposes for, duration of, and pre-conditions governing the creation of school district sinking funds, allowing a levy of 5 mills against the taxable value of the real and personal property of the school district for the new purposes of buying buses, bus maintenance, and technology. These bonds could be levied for up to 10 years. (Districts could continue to levy mills whose revenue would pay-off bonds over a 20-year time-period, in order to purchase real estate and to construct and repair school buildings.)

AFT MICHIGAN POSITION - YES

HOUSE VOTE #80: 74 YES / 35 NO / 0 EXCUSED / 1 NOT VOTING

HOUSE BILL 4047 - FIRST CLASS DISTRICT

House Bill 4047 specifies that a school district having a first class school district designation as of September 1, 2008 would continue to have that designation until July 1, 2010, regardless of its pupil membership. (Currently, a school district needs 100,000 students to be classified as a district of the first class; only the Detroit Public Schools qualify.)

SENATE BILL 698 - ALGEBRA II REQUIREMENT: CTE PROGRAM

Senate Bill 698 would permit a pupil to meet the algebra II requirement of Michigan Merit Curriculum by completing an approved CTE program that has embedded math content.

HOUSE BILL 4511 - MATH GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND PERSONAL CURRICULUM

House Bill 4511 would alter the process to be used when modifying the Michigan Merit Curriculum; 1) specifying that a personal curriculum could be sought for a student who has completed Grade 9; and 2) expanding the list of those who can request the personal curriculum on behalf of a student to include teachers and counselors (in addition to parents). In addition, the bill would allow modification of the high school mathematics requirements to occur after a student has completed 1 ½ credits of math (without necessarily having attained a passing grade), instead of having successfully completed 2 ½ credits.

HOUSE BILL 4410 - MATHEMATIC REQUIREMENTS

House Bill 4410 would modify the four-year mathematics requirement in the Michigan Merit Curriculum to require a credit in algebra I, a credit in geometry (or the equivalent in a career and tech course), a credit in financial literacy or algebra II (or the equivalent in a career and tech course) or an integrated sequence of this course consisting of three credits, and a fourth math credit in a course such as trigonometry, statistics, pre-calculus, calculus, applied math, accounting, business math, algebra II (or the equivalent in a career and tech course), a re-take of algebra II, a financial literacy course, or a career and tech education course with math content approved by the board of the school district or charter school.

HOUSE BILL 4441 - HIGHER EDUCATION BUDGET (PUBLIC ACT 132, 2009)

House Bill 4441 cuts 2009 - 2010 Higher Education operational funding by 0.4 percent from the current year. It also eliminates all funding for Michigan Promise Grants. Both exam-based award payments (2008 and 2009 high school classes) and back-end award payments (2007 high school class) are eliminated.

House Bill 4997 would allow public employees to contribute to political action committees through payroll deduction, if their collective bargaining unit provides full compensation to the public body for the service.

SENATE BILL 638 - TEACHERS' TENURE ACT

Senate Bill 638 would amend the Teachers' Tenure Act to add consistent ineffectiveness in teaching as a ground for the discharge or demotion of a teacher on continuing tenure.

HOUSE BILL 4580 - POLICY PROHIBITING HARASSMENT AND BULLYING IN SCHOOL

House Bill 4580 requires public schools to adopt a policy prohibiting harassment and bullying at school. The bill encourages school boards to include in its policy provisions concerning education, parental involvement, reporting, investigation, and intervention.

SENATE BILL 1227 - MICHIGAN PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM REFORM (As Enacted)

Senate Bill 1227 requires that all MPSERS employees contribute 3% of their compensation into a funding account beginning July 1, 2010. It allows employees to be eligible to retire if they have a combined age and years of service totaling 80 by September 1, 2010. For members who retire by September 1, 2010, the bill provides a 1.6% multiplier in the pension formula for an employee who is eligible to retire under current eligibility and a 1.55% multiplier for members who qualify under the 80 and out. The bill moves all newly hired school employees after July 1, 2010 into a hybrid pension and defined contribution system. For retirees who retire after July 1, 2010, the bill allows them to maintain pension and health benefits if they earn less than 1/3 of their final average compensation. If they earn more than 1/3 of their final average compensation, their pension and health care benefits will be suspended until the employment ends. For those retirees who retire after July 1, 2010, but are employed independently or by a third party, the bill suspends their pension and health care benefits during their employment.
